3 School Selection and Ranking

How the ranked application works: **1)** Assign a number to each school you would like to apply to (#1 being your most preferred school.) **2)** Do not assign the same number to more than one school. **3) If accepted at more than one school, we will only reserve a seat for your child at the higher ranked school.** **4)** If you do not rank your selected schools, they will automatically be ranked by proximity to your child's address (closest to furthest).

Your child will be entered in the lottery for each of the schools you have applied to, regardless of the ranking number. Ranking a school higher or lower does not increase or decrease your child's chances of being offered a seat at that school. Your rankings will only be used to offer a seat to your child at your preferred Uncommon school if he or she is offered a seat at more than one school through the lottery.
